Purpose The purpose of this submission is to revise your label in accordance PR Notice 2001-1 (First Aid) and PR Notice 2001-6 (homeowner disposal text).

Label The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

1. Place your disclaimer in a section separate from the "**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**", preferably in a box.

Notice: Buyer assumes all risk of use, storage, and handling of this material not in strict accordance with label directions.

- 2. Revise your homeowner “**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**” text as follows, in accordance with PR Notice 2001-6:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse empty container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or [toll free number which meets the criteria in paragraph II.E. of PR Notice 2002-6] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

- 3. Use Enclosure 2 as a guide to revise your “**FIRST AID**” text.

Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Avoid prolonged skin contact.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to inter-tidal areas below the mean water mark.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

FIRST AID

If Inhaled: Move Person to fresh air.

.... If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

.... Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing.

.... Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

.... Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.

.... Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

.... Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

.... Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.

.... Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.

.... Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container with you when call a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Note to physician:

If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY. APPLY ONLY AS DIRECTED ON LABEL. To repel rattlesnakes (Genus Crotalus) and checkered garter (Thamnophis Marcianus) from areas around houses, cabins, trailers, garages, utility houses, barns, woodpiles, sand piles, trash cans, and flower beds. May also be used around the periphery of gardens. Do not use this product at sites where snakes are believed to be already present as the deterrent effects of the product might tend to confine snakes to the treated areas.

Do not apply this product in gardens or in fields of crops grown for food or feed. Do not use this product near streams, ponds, pools, or water supplies.

Tests of this product have suggested that it can be effective deterrent for the types of snakes listed above. While the product might deter other types of snakes as well, it is not expected to consistently repel snakes of the following types: corn snakes and other rat snakes (Genus Elaphe); and "moccasin" snakes such as cottonmouths and copperheads (Genus Agkistrodon).

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Using gloves, apply SNAKE-A-WAY IN BANDS SURROUNDING THE AREA TO BE PROTECTED. Use bands 4 to 5 inches wide to repel checkered garter snakes. For rattlesnakes, use bands 8 to 12 inches wide. In yards, lightly sprinkle SNAKE-A-WAY over the area within the treatment band.

When the odor of SNAKE-A-WAY becomes faint, its effectiveness may be diminished. If this occurs during a season when snakes are active, retreat with enough of the product to restore the original odor intensity. Retreatment may also be necessary after heavy rains.

RATS AND MICE:

USE RESTRICTIONS: FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY. APPLY ONLY AS DIRECTED ON LABEL. This product may be used to limit damage by house mice (Mus musculus), Norway rats (Rattus norvegicus), or roof rats (R. Rattus) to garbage bags placed near residences and other buildings or to garbage bags placed along streets or alleys for garbage collection.

Do not use this product in gardens or in fields of crops grown for food or feed. Do not use this product near streams, ponds, pools, water supplies, or sewers.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Using gloves, apply Rat Scat, in a lightly sprinkled band around the area where garbage bags are placed. Beginning no more than one foot out from the outermost bags, lightly broadcast Rat Scat until band of product is 24 inches wide circles the bags.

When the odor of Rat Scat becomes faint, its effectiveness may be diminished. Retreatment may also be necessary after heavy, washing-type rains.
