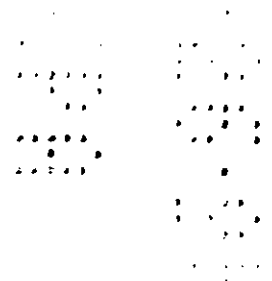

Do not apply product directly to foliage or stems. Hot weather and wind will necessitate more frequent applications.

) DIRECTIONS FOR INDOOR USE: SQUIRRELS & BATS: Spread Dr. T's Rabbit, Squirrel, Bat and Bird Repellent on floors, or apply between walls, using 8 ounces for every 200 cubic feet. Squirrels and bats will depart from treated spaces within a short time after which all openings through which they gain entrance such as small crevices around eaves, rafters, around dormers, should be closed by means of strips of wood, metal or by use of steel wool.

BIRDS: Starlings, pigeons or sparrows can be controlled with the same method used for squirrels and bats.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and sunlight.
