





Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use and described as above. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick and flea control product prior to re-entry.
