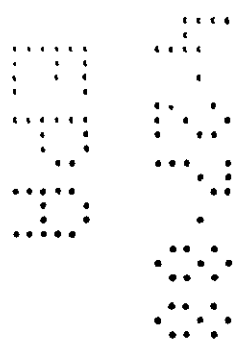

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.  
IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Attach one tag per animal in the spring to control horn flies for that summer season. Tags are easy to apply or replace as necessary. Attach two tags per animal to control face flies, gulf coast ticks, spinose ear ticks and as an aid in the control of lice, stableflies and houseflies.

INSECTICIDAL EAR TAGS are easy to attach using a variety of methods. They may be punched through an existing ear tag using the Fearing tagging system. However, tags punched through adult sized identification tags on young calves may result in tearing the ear and loss of the tags. Tags may also be positioned across entryways where animals are forced to use them as they gain access to barns, feeders, waterers or milking areas.

Calves and cows may mutilate tags by sucking and chewing. Effectiveness against ectoparasites may be reduced.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Remove tags before slaughter. Keep container sealed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wrap used tags and dispose of in trash containers.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Additional Claims Requested

Directions for use as a Mite-T-Bar: Hang one bar strop in the center of each cage of up to five (5) birds as an aid in the prevention and control of Northern Fowl Mites in poultry. Use a pig ring and/or the enclosed plastic hanger to suspend the bar so that the bottom of the inverted (T) (J) is 1 to 2 inches below the back height of the shortest bird in each cage. Properly positioned bars will prevent mites for up to two (2) years. Control of heavy mite infestations may require use of more than one bar per cage of five (5) birds for one to three months.
