**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
**Directions for Use in Poultry Houses: Caged Layer:** Use enclosed clip to attach strip at a cross-wire, one third distance from front of every cage of up to five (5) birds as an aid in the prevention and control of the Northern fowl mites and lice in poultry. Control of heavy mite infestations may require use of more than one strip per cage of five (5) birds for one to three months.  
**Breeder Use:** Use the enclosed clip to suspend strip center front of each nest hole. Add one additional strip for each five (5) roosters, strategically placed, where rooster will have daily contact. Properly positioned strips will prevent mites and lice for up to two (2) years.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:**

Remove strips when cleaning cages. Securely wrap used strips in a plastic bag or several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:**

Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
