Wear protective gloves when attaching strips to cages. Control of heavy mite infestations may require use of more than one strip per cage of five (5) birds for one to three months.

Breeder Use: Use the enclosed clip to suspend strip center front of each nest hole. Add one additional strip for each five (5) roosters, strategically placed, where rooster will have daily contact. Properly positioned strips will prevent mites and lice for up to two (2) years.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Remove strips when cleaning cages. Securely wrap used strips in a plastic bag or several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
