USE IN POULTRY HOUSES

Caged Layer: Use the enclosed clip to attach strip at a cross-wire, one third distance from front of every cage of up to five (5) birds as an aid in the prevention and control of the Northern fowl mite and lice in poultry. Control of heavy mite infestation may require use of more than one strip per cage of five (5) birds for one to three months.

Breeder: Use the enclosed clip to suspend strip center front of each nest hole. Add one additional strip for each five (5) roosters, strategically placed, where rooster will have daily contact. Properly positioned strips will prevent mites and lice for up to two (2) years.

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Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Pesticide Disposal: Remove strips when cleaning cages. Securely wrap used strips in a plastic bag or several layers

of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.
