

- e. On Page 3 put the statement "This product adheres, hardens and remains where applied on hard surfaces" as a separate paragraph directly before the heading "DOMESTIC (HOMECOWNER) USE."
- f. On Page 4, change last sentence in second paragraph to read:  
"Press small amounts directly into cracks and crevices and remove any excess".
- g. On Page 5, delete "Container Disposal: [See Appendix A on Page 2 of PR Notice 83-3]".

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

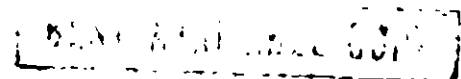

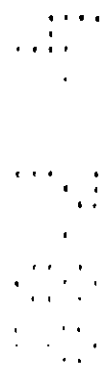

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces.
