The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

Label Comments:

- A. Underneath the "Statement of Practical Treatment" after the word "physician" add the words "if swallowed".
- B. After the "Storage and Disposal" statement add "Pesticide Disposal: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of onsite or at an approved waste disposal facility."
- C. Under the statement "Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent)", add "Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash".
- D. Under the "Warranty Statement" remove the paragraph "Note: For average... few days". and place under Directions For Use.

ROACH X-ODDS IS AN ODORLESS, NON-FLAMMABLE THICK PASTE-LIKE FORMULA THAT ADHERES, HARDENS AND REMAINS ON HARD SURFACES SUCH AS METAL, WOOD AND HARD PLASTIC. ALSO, MAY BE PRESSED ON TRAYS AND PLACED IN INACCESSIBLE PLACES AWAY FROM CHILDREN AND PETS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Press paste in about one ounce lumps using a spatula or knife to spread to about 1/4 to 1/2 inch thickness behind and under furniture and floor and counter appliances such as stoves, sinks, toasters, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs, hard-back parts of couches, dressers and chests of drawers, bookcases, into openings around drains, water pipes and conduits and in corners of sink cabinets, pantries, cupboards and closets. Also, paste may be pressed into cracks and crevices. And also, paste may be pressed on trays and placed in inaccessible places. Remove any deposits of paste in exposed surfaces. **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS IN ALL FOOD HANDLING AND FOOD SERVING RESTAURANTS, ALSO, IN PROCESSING PLANTS UNDER STATE INSPECTION INCLUDING PACKAGING, BOTTLING AND CANNING PLANTS SUCH AS NON-SHELL SEAFOOD, DAIRIES AND DAIRY PRODUCTS, SAUCES, SPREADS, DRESSINGS, BAKERIES AND CONFECTIONERIES AND WAREHOUSES:** Apply paste by pressing with a knife or spatula, rubber gloves may be used, to about 1/4 to 1/2 inch thickness in areas limited to use under and behind stationary counter and floor appliances and furniture and in corners of sink cabinets, pantries, cupboards and closets. (Appliances and furniture to include stoves, refrigerators, freezers, sinks, utility and work tables, ice and drink machines and booths.) Also, may be pressed into cracks and crevices. ALSO Paste may be pressed in about one ounce lumps on trays

and placed under and behind furniture and appliances along walls. Reapply as necessary. **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS IN NON-FOOD AREAS:** Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers entries and vestibules), office building areas, garages, mop closets and storage. Apply as spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables and similar areas where roaches may hide or through which they may enter to include by pressing under outdoor doorstoops.
