

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE  
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WT-310 ALGACIDE is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To insure its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of WT-310 ALGACIDE fluid ounces of WT-310 ALGACIDE of water to provide a concentration of 48 WT-310 ALGACIDE base in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dose of WT-310 ALGACIDE Subsequent slug additions of 1.53 WT-310 ALGACIDE per 1000 gallons of WT-310 ALGACIDE 120 parts per million of WT-310 ALGACIDE

employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump. WT-310 ALGACIDE is used in air-washing systems that maintain effective residual chlorine. To insure its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 24.7 WT-310 ALGACIDE per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected. Slug additions of 16.9 to 41.2 fluid ounces of WT-310 ALGACIDE per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. Frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in collection trays of the airwash system.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and the container closed when not in use.
