For decorative fountains, use PL-500 POOL ALGACIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add 8 fluid ounces of PL-500 POOL ALGACIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of established algae growth, remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of established algae growth, add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of PL-500 POOL ALGACIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of PL-500 POOL ALGACIDE should be made 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
