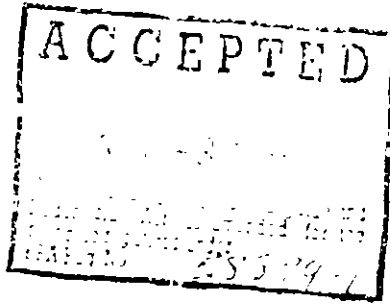


AS-105



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide inconsistent with its labeling.

... is used in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 1.0 lb. AS-105 per 1000 gal. is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Subsequent slug additions of 0.5 lb. AS-105 per 1000 gal. every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing the active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing the product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not store in five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Damaged drums should be placed in overpack and should not be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes, sprays, excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a hazardous waste. These wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to the label. State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency representative at your EPA Regional Office for disposal instructions.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: METAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then recycle, if possible, for other uses. If not, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or procedures approved by state and local authorities. PLASTIC: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then recycle, if possible, for other uses. If not, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or procedures approved by state and local authorities, by incineration, or other approved methods.
