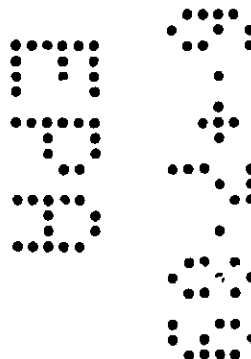

# SPECIMEN LABEL

## REAR PANEL

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Kills exposed or accessible stages of these insects:

Ants	Flies	Fleas	Silverfish
Cockroaches	Fruit Flies	Gnats	Spiders

One 5 ounce aerosol can treats up to 5,000 cubic feet.

One 12 ounce can treats up to 12,000 cubic feet.

#### How to Use:

Open all cabinet doors and drawers to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets and tightly cover or remove fish bowls or aquariums. Cover exposed foods, dishes or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Put out all lights including pilot lights.

#### Directions

SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING. Place can on level raised surfaces such as stand or table, with protective covering underneath to prevent possible marring of surface. With can at arm's length, direct spray away from face. Depress tab until it clicks in locked position. Exit immediately. Keep area closed for 10 minutes. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate before reoccupying.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

##### CAUTION

Use in food processing plants should be confined to time periods when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes.

##### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.  
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
