To be used in and around homes, apartments, commercial buildings, kenne barns, patios, institutions, warehouses, theaters, office buildings, schools, motels, hotels, transformers, electrical boxes and those areas where wasps, hornet and yellow jacket nests are generally located. To operate, remove protective cap and press button, being sure to aim spray opening at the location to be sprayed. Direct spray at wasps hornets and yellow jackets whenever possible and under eaves, into nests, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed.
