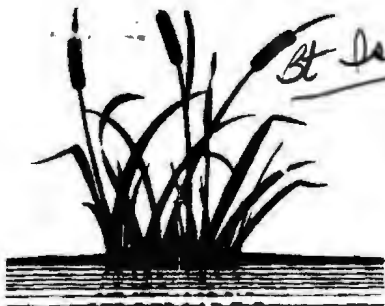

PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If on skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush eyes with
water until any irritation has stopped. If inhaled, remove victim
to fresh air. If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Hazards to humans: Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing.
Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
Environmental hazards: Do not apply directly to treated, finished
drinking water reservoirs or drinking water receptacles.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
SKEETAL is a larvicide dependent upon the presence of a selective natural toxin which when
eaten by the mosquito or blackfly larvae breaks down in the insect's gut. Paralysis and death
follow normally within 4-8 hours, control being complete within 24 hours. The natural toxin
has been shown to be an effective pesticide against over 30 species of mosquito larvae and
several species of blackfly (*Simulium* spp.). Among the mosquitoes controlled are those belong-
ing to the genera *Aedes*, *Anopheles*, *Culex*, *Culiseta*, *Psorophora*, and *Wyeomyia*, and *Uranotaenia*.
In most cases, 1st to 3rd instar larvae are the most susceptible, although 4th instar
can be controlled.

Shake the container before use. Partially fill the spray tank with water, add required volume
of SKEETAL, stir and continue filling the tank. For maximum efficiency, the mixture should
be used the same day. Application can be made using any standard spray equipment, and
in any volume of water suitable for adequate coverage. For aerial application, apply neat or
diluted with water to preference.

SKEETAL is exempt from the requirements of a tolerance on raw agricultural commodities.
Applications to irrigation water are permissible. SKEETAL may be used in residential areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of waste.
Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use.
Store in temperatures above freezing and below 32 degrees C (90 degrees F).
Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on
site or at an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with federal and
local regulations.
Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning; or puncture
and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration or, if allowed by state
and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Larvae	Application made upstream, SKEETAL mixed with up to 3-5 times its own volume of water	10 to 50 milligrams SKEETAL FC per liter of water flowing downstream per minute (1.2-6.4 oz per 1000 gal. of flow per minute). Apply to assure a minimum of one minute of exposure of the larvae.
