**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER**

**Corrosive.** Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, or on clothing. Do not breathe dust.
