

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING

GREEN CHARM SEVIN 5% Brand Carbaryl Insecticide DUST may be applied with any suitable dust applicator. For best results **EGGPLANT**: Com Earworm, Flea Beetles, Hornworms, Cumake application in the morning or evening when the air is still. Be sure to treat both upper and lower surfaces of leaves. Apply (down wind) to give thorough coverage but avoid applying in excess. Applications should be started when insects first appear, Repeat as necessary. Apply at 7 to 10 day intervals, or 3 to 5 day intervals in rainy weather. Listed below are the crops with the pests controlled followed by the time interval to stop applications prior to harvest. As a general rule apply enough dust to give POTATOES (White); Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Carl apply thorough coverage to all plant parts or 11 to 15 ounces per 1,000. day of harvest sq.ft. (equal to to 40 lbs. dust per acre.)

Apply % az. to cover 250 sq.ft. of turf or around building foundation area to control Earwigs - Millipedes - Sod Webworms - Leafhoppers and Ants. Area should be lightly sprinkled after application to wash dust of: foliage. Repeat as necessary, Keep children and pets off treated areas until grass has been sprinkled and area is dry.

FLEAS ON DOGS & CATS

For control of Fleas, and Brown Dog Ticks, rub 1/2 to 1 level tablespoonful into pets skin. AF citiest sineolog, loading and other infested quarters. Replace with fresh bodying. VEGETABLES and FRUIT

ASPARAGUS: Asparagus Beetles. Do not apply later than 1 day before harvest. Do not apply more often than once every 3 days.

BEANS: Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean Leaf Beetle, Leafhoppers, Flee Baetles, Com Earwonne, Lygus Bugs, Stink Bugs, Lime Been Pod Borer, Japanese Beetle. Can be applied day of harvest

BEETS (table): Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, 3 days before harvest. 14 days before harvest if tops are used for food or feed.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS, BROCCOLL CABBAGE, CAULI-FLOWER: Small Cabbage Looper, (trust every 5 to 7 days for control), Armyworms, Flea Beetles. Do not apply later than 3 days before harvest.

CARROTS: Leafhoppers, Flea Beetles. Can be applied day of

CITRUS: Black Scale, California Red Scale, Soft Brown Scale, Orange Tortrix, California Orange Dog, Fruit Tree Leaf Rollers. For Scale insects best results are obtained when crawing a a present. Apply 5 days before harvest.

COLLARDS, KALE, MUSTARD GREENS, RADISHES,

RUTABAGAS, CHINESE CABBAGE, HORSERADISH and TURNIPS: Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bug, Leafhoppers, Armyworm, Imported Cabbageworm, Tamished Plant Bug and Stink Bugs, (3 days of harvest on horseradish, radishes, rutabagas and turnip roots; 14 days on Chinese cabbage, collards, kale. mustard greens and turnip tops).

<u>CORN(Sweet)</u>: Com Earworm, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Fall Armyworms. For Corn Earworm control treat corn silks every 3 days until silks dry. Can apply day of harvest.

CUCUMBERS, MELONS, SQUASH, PUMPKINS, CANTA-LOUPES: Squash Bugs, Leafhoppers, Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles. Do not apply to Melons or Cucumbers when termore. tures exceed 80° F or when vines are wet. Can be applied of harvest.

LETTUCE: Armyworms, Small Cabbage Looper (treat every 5 to 7 days for control), Leafhoppers, Sait Marsh Caterpillars, For Head Lettuce; 3 days before harvest. Leaf Lettuce; 14 days before hervest.

PEPPERS: Com Earworm, Leafhoppers, Flea Beetles. Can be applied up to day of harvest.

<u>TOMATQE8</u>: Tomato Fruit Worm, Tomato Hornworm, Flea Beetles, Stink Bug, Leafhoppers. Apply day of harvest.

STRAWBERRIES: Leaf Rollers, Lygus Bugs, Salt Marsh Caterpillar. One day before harvest

ORNAMENTALS

CRNAMENTAL FLOWERS, SHRI'BS AND TREES Apply this product to thoroughly cover the plant foliage for control of the following pests. Repeat as needed for continued control.
