This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA Section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA Section 4 when the Agency required all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 59144-7."
- b. In the Precautionary Statements section:
 - Expand the note following the signal word to explain "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin."
 - Replace the Environmental Hazards Statement with the following:
 This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish and aquatic invertebrates. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Clean up spilled product to reduce exposure to wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Runoff

- Add the following statement:

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

c. In the Statement of Practical Treatment section:

- Amend the instructions for treatment if swallowed to delete all wording prior to "To induce vomiting,..."
- Add a note to remove contaminated clothing if product comes into contact with skin.

d. In the section addressing Pests Indoors:

- Mediterranean Flour Moths are listed among the pests this product will control. However, the general term "Moths" is also included on the list. You may wish to clarify the redundancy by specifying another type of moth.
- Amend the current statement to: "Spot treatment may encompass crack and crevice treatment by applying..."
- Delete the period and insert a colon (:) in its place between the statements regarding application within residential buildings and "For Spot Treatment Only."
- Change "Cover Mites" to "Clover Mites; add "s" to Earwig.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

4. Within 15 months of the date of this registration, submit a storage stability study in which the formulated product is analyzed for the active ingredient at time zero and during one year of storage at warehouse conditions of time and temperature in the product's commercial package. Please note that you may not reference the data on the product concentrate that you are using to formulate your product.

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If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PESTS INDOORS

General Information: Use Green Charm Home Pest Insect Control to control the pests indicated in the areas listed below by application of the product as an undiluted spray (0.5% Chlorpyrifos). Repeat treatments as needed. Do not spray this product into conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazards. Do not use in poultry houses or other animal buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying. Application Within Food Handling Establishments (Places Other Than Private Residences in Which Food Is Held, Prepared or Served) including, But Not Limited to Restaurants, Grocery Stores, Bakeries, Bottling Plants, Canneries, and Grain Mills: Use as a spot treatment in and around both food and non-food areas to control cockroaches (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides) Ants, Moths, Rice Weevil, Mediterranean Flour Moths, and Red Flour Beetles. Apply as a coarse, low pressure (20 psi or less) spray to localized areas. Do not introduce the spray into the air or allow the spray to contact food or food-contacting surfaces. Areas treated may include dark corners of rooms and closets; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind stoves, refrigeration units and similar food preparation areas and equipment; floor drains; and around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants apply to ant trails and wherever these pests may find entrance. Spot treatment may encompass crack and crevice treatment by apply small amounts of material directly into openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases or which occur at points between different elements of construction or between equipment and floor. Spray Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide should be used. Repeat treatment as needed but not more often than once every 7 days in restaurants and similar food service establishments or more often than once every 14 days in other types of food handling establishments. Home Pest Control Spray may be applied after 2 days from the last treatment, but emergency use should be limited to once per month.
