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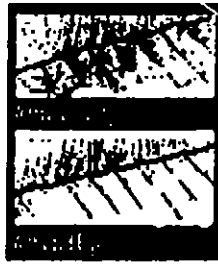

The contents of this container will treat 300 square feet of lawn at home and in commercial areas for the control of a wide variety of weeds in and along driveways, sidewalks, on patios, parking lots, filling stations, and other areas of unwanted vegetation. Used as the initial step in a lawn renovation program. Apply to contact with the soil. Spray weeds to point of runoff. Expect browning and browning in about 5 to 7 days. Best kill is obtained when weeds are growing vigorously during hot sunny weather.

**HOW TO USE**  
**SPOT WEED TREATMENT**

This product is read-to-use. Applicator should wear protective clothing. For treatment of individual weeds (spot treatment) invert the applicator head, invert jug several inches above ground. Spray weeds in and along sidewalks, patio blocks, driveway edges, and lawn. Product will cause brown or yellowing dead spots. Avoid continued weed edging.

**TREATMENT FOR LAWN RENOVATION**

The area should be mowed before treatment. For renovation of portions of a lawn, the contents of this container will treat 300 sq.ft. Invert the container and sprinkle directly onto weeds with a garden pressure sprayer. A second application 5 to 7 days later will complete kill of Bermudagrass and other deep rooted weeds. After brown the area should be raked and bare spots prepared. After last treatment, water thoroughly and then seed at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Seed should be raked into soil and kept moist until green. Allow Liquid-Edger to come in contact with the foliage, and plants since injury may occur.

**STORAGE and DISPOSAL**
