The above mentioned label submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provide you make the following changes:

- 1. Change "Precautionary Statements" to the following:

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
Caution

"Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust, contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Keep away from feed or food products. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling or using."

- 2. Change the "Environmental Hazards statement" to the following:

Environmental Hazards: "Atrazine can travel (seep or leach) through soil and can enter ground water which may be used as drinking water. Atrazine has been found in ground water. Users are advised not apply atrazine

3. Change the "Statement of Practical Treatment" to the following:



HOW & WHEN TO APPLY

Apply in January, February, or early March to prevent germination of crabgrass, bull paspalum, sedges (from seed), and spotted spurge. Apply anytime broadleaf weeds are growing to get control. Apply in the fall to control henbit, chickweed and other winter weeds. If complete control is not obtained, a second application may be necessary 2 months after the first. For best results apply with a fertilizer spreader at the settings listed below. Apply to newly sprigged St. Augustine or Zoysia lawns to help prevent competition from other weeds. Apply when grass blades are dry. On hot days (above 80 degrees) water the lawn to rinse particles off the grass.
