



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply in January, February or early March to prevent germination of crabgrass, bull paspalum, sedges (from seed) and spotted spurge. To get control apply anytime broadleaf weeds are growing. Apply in the fall to control henbit, chickweed and other winter weeds. If complete control is not obtained, a second application may be necessary 2 months after the first. For best results apply with a fertilizer spreader at the settings listed below. Apply to newly sprigged St. Augustine or Zoysia lawns to help prevent competition from other weeds. Apply when grass blades are dry. On hot days (above 80°F) water the lawn to rinse particles off the grass.
