

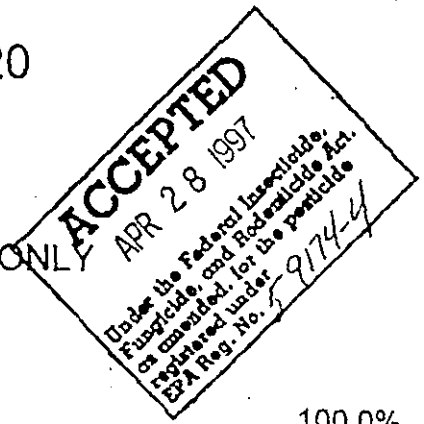
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- III. A copy of the stamped label is provided for your records.
