 - f. The section entitled "indications" should appear on the front panel on the labeling.
 - g. The ingredient statements must be moved to the front panel of the label. Please see the attached label.
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

INGREDIENTS: Roughage products, dehydrated alfalfa meal, dried molasses, mineral oil, and artificial flavoring.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Start feeding EQUI-FLY[®] Count Down early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer and into the fall or when cold weather restricts normal fly activity.

700 - 900 lb. horse: Feed 4/5 oz. per horse per day.

900 - 1100 lb. horse: Feed 1 oz. per horse per day.

For horses over 1100 lb. of body weight, feed 1/4 oz. for each additional 250 lb. of body weight.

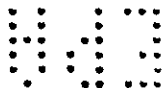
