

- b. On page 3, in the ***Storage and Disposal*** section, under the “**Pesticide Disposal**” statement, insert the following language: “Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times”. These changes are required per the guidance from PR Notice 2007-4 (Labeling Revisions Required by the Final Rule” Pesticide Management and Disposal; Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment).
- c. In the ***Storage and Disposal*** section, under the “**Container Disposal**” statement, insert the language “Nonfillable container”. Do not reuse or refill this container” These changes are required per the guidance from PR Notice 2007-4.
- d. In the ***Storage and Disposal*** section, under the “**Container Disposal**” statement, the product must bear a batch code. This is a lot number of other code used by the registrant or producer to identify the batch of the pesticide product distributed and sold. This information is required per the guidance from PR Notice 2007-4.
- e. Since your product is packaged in multiple container types (1, 2.3 and 30 gallon), you must comply with the container and containment labeling requirements as in described in PR Notice 2007-4. You may submit separate labels for each container type and/or size, or may submit a single label with alternate storage and disposal statements. For pesticide disposal, letter “B” above describes language for residue removal for a container type that is “less than 5 gallons”. Alternative language for residue removal needs to be submitted for those containers greater than 5 gallons. Please refer to PR Notice 2007-4 to obtain the language.
- f. On page 2, under the **Directions for Use** section, delete the following language: “For formulation into antimicrobial products for use as a preservative in the following applications”. In its place, insert the following: “Use the product to formulate EPA registered preservative products which are used in the following textile applications”.
- g. On page 2, under the **Directions for Use** section, the following uses must be deleted from the listing: Brush bristles, sponges, carpet backing, and packaging. More descriptive language to specify what type of use it constitutes needs to be included.
- h. On page 2, in the use listing under the **Apparel** section, add the word “cloth” in front of the word “shoes”.
- i. On page 2, under the **Directions for Use** section (near the beginning of that section), insert the following statement: “Formulated pesticide products must indicate use of silver chloride in finished treated textile articles. Use levels must not exceed 0.2% by of treated goods”.
- j. On page 2, move the statement “Formulators using this product are responsible for providing data and obtaining an EPA registration of their formulated products” to the top, near the beginning of the **Directions for Use** section.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

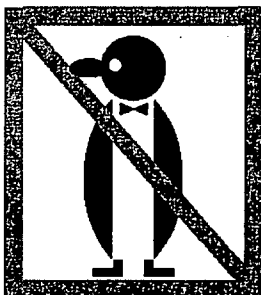

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
