FIRST AID

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is intended for formulating end use microbiological water purification systems to treat water for drinking water purposes. Manufacturers of microbiological water purification systems using this iodinated resin must obtain their own registration from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store this product in non-metallic containers resistant to the corrosive action of iodine, such as glass containers or fiber drums lined with polyethylene. Keep moist (preferably with deionized water), by storing resin beads with a small layer of water above the settled resin. Do not store in open or unlabeled containers.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: This resin contains Iodine (I₂), which is corrosive to most metals. Do not dispose resin in sewers or storm drains. Place in non-metallic containers and dispose in sanitary landfill approved for pesticide disposal.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then offer for recycling if available or dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner as liner.
