

Only to be used for the treatment of potable water. This product is to be used only in the manufacturing of bacteriostatic water treatment devices for home or household use. Manufacturers of water treatment devices are responsible for compliance with applicable regulatory requirements.

Do not mix this product or permit contact with strong oxidizing agents, e.g. free chlorine or concentrated nitric acid.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.
