Additionally, the subheading "Statement of Practical Treatments" should be relocated just before the "If inhaled" sentence as an introduction to the practical treatments.

Finally, in the precautionary statements, add the following precaution: "Not for use on horses to be used for food".

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. FORMULA "Z" 2001 has been especially developed for use on animals. It provides a protective hair coating against flies, while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. Using one to two ounces per head per day will give adequate protection. Apply by either a soft cloth or a fine mist spray.

USED AS A SPRAY:

FORMULA "Z" 2001 may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area, and around stable area for fast paralysis to kill flies. Do not wet animals skin, or exceed two ounces per application. To control blood sucking lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get spray to the base of the hair.

USE AS A WIPE ON:

First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Pay special attention to the legs, shoulders, shank, neck and facial areas where flies are most often seen. Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your animal. Do not wet skin after application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.

FORMULA "Z" 2001 is formulated for horses, cattle, and domestic animals.

FORMULA "Z" 2001 is also a grooming aid and coat conditioner

FORMULA "Z" 2001 kills and repels Stable Flies, Horn Flies, House Flies, Face Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Ticks, Fleas, and Lice.
