DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

For Use on Small Animals: Remove animal from cage. Hold bottle upright and point nozzle opening in desired direction of spray. Spray the animal from a distance of 3-12 inches.

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under body. Fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes or face. Allow animal to dry before returning it to cage. As animal dries, keep it in a warm area to prevent it from getting chills. Repeat as necessary.

For Use on Cage Surfaces to Control Fleas, Ticks, Mites and Lice: Remove animal(s)' food and water cups, etc. Cages should be cleaned in hot water weekly. Spray cage surfaces from at least one foot, using 5 or 6 pumps per cage. Spray outside of the cage bottom thoroughly as fleas and ticks often live there.

REPEAT TREATMENT ON CAGES AND ON SMALL ANIMALS AS NECESSARY

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or sunlight. Protect from freezing.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash skin with soap and water after using. Avoid spraying food or foodstuffs. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Promptly drink one or two glasses of water and contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.
