DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

For Use Directly on Birds to Control Bird Mites and Lice: Leave birds in cage. Remove food and water. Spray directly on birds from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Avoid the bird's eyes and face. Lightly spray with 3 or 4 pumps. As bird dries, keep it in a warm area to prevent it from getting chills. Repeat twice a week.

For Use on Cage And Aviary Surfaces to Control Feather Mites: Remove bird(s)' food and water cups, etc. Bird cages should be cleaned in hot water weekly. Spray cage and aviary surfaces from at least one foot, using 5 or 6 pumps per cage. Spray outside of the cage bottom thoroughly as feather mites often live there.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or sunlight. Protect from freezing.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash skin with soap and water after using. Avoid spraying food or foodstuffs. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Promptly drink one or two glasses of water and contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if needed.

If On Skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to reuse.

If In Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
