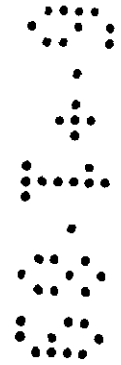

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Concentrate may cause skin damage. Use waterproof gloves when handling concentrate. In case of contact, immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin or eyes with plenty of water. For eyes, get medical attention. Avoid wetting the hides of animals.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, give water to drink and telephone for medical advice. DO NOT make person vomit unless directed to do so by medical personnel. If medical advice cannot be obtained, then take person and product container to nearest medical emergency treatment center or hospital. For skin contact, immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. In case of eye contact, wash eyes immediately with fresh water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if eye or skin irritation persists. If inhaled, remove person from exposure area.

Note to Physicians: Emergency information: call (415) 233-3737. This product contains an aromatic petroleum distillate and an aspiration hazard may exist. Naled is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If signs and symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear, atropine is antidotal. Z-PAM may also be used in conjunction with atropine but should not be used alone.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

COMBUSTIBLE. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DO NOT USE OR STORE near heat, open flame, sparks or hot surfaces. **USE ONLY IN WELL VENTILATED AREA.** Keep container closed. Clean up spills immediately. Liquid evaporates and forms vapor (fumes) which can catch fire and burn with explosive violence. DIRECTIONS

DIBROM Fly & Mosquito Spray is suitable for use in Fog Guns, Micro-sol Foggers, Heat Generating Foggers, Dairy Barn Foggers, Hydro Guns or suitable automatic atomizing application equipment. May corrode metal spray equipment. Flush sprayers out occasionally with kerosene to prevent possible corrosion.

USE UNLIMITED: Apply as a finely atomized space spray using applicator adjusted to produce particle sizes not smaller than 30 microns.

GENERAL USE — In and Around Dwellings, Open Air Horse Stables, Garbage Bumps, Outside Meat Packing Plants, Mosquitoes, Gnats. Direct spray throughout in milk processing rooms. Do not use fog applications where food is commercially prepared or processed. **DAIRY BARN FOGGERS —** Non-stain and Non-residue cubic feet of space. Close all doors and windows which directly at animals. Do not use in milk processing rooms, **WIREMESH, CARCASSES, RIDER MILLS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, FLOORS, DOORWAYS, WINDOWS, REFUSE PILES AND CLOACES (Water Bugs) — Spot Application Only in American Roaches in and Around Dwellings, Dairy Barns, insects as much as possible. Treat daily or as necessary.**

Do not apply under conditions involving possible drift.

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or application. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE
