

ORTHENE® Tobacco Insect Spray

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed drink 1 or 2 glasses of water (or milk) and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. If possible contact a physician, Poison Control Center, or emergency center before inducing vomiting. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take person and product container to the nearest emergency treatment center. In case of eye contact, wash eyes with fresh water for 15 minutes. If irritation continues, see a doctor. For skin contact, wash skin with plenty of soap and water. If inhaled, remove person from exposure area. Refer to Physician. Emergency Information — call (415) 233-3737. Acephate is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If signs of cholinesterase inhibition appear, atropine or antedol 2-PAM may also be used in conjunction with atropine but should not be used alone.

Written or oral warnings regarding use of protective clothing and accidental exposure must be given to workers who are expected to be in treated areas or in areas about to be treated.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PRECONDITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Store in a cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat. TRANSPLANT WATER APPLICATION

Tobacco	Ree Beede, Green Peach Aphid, Tobacco Aphid, Cutworm	1

Provides control of early season Ree beetles, green peach aphids, tobacco aphids and cutworm for approximately 3-4 weeks after transplanting. For later season control of these insects, apply a foliar spray of ORTHENE Tobacco Insect Spray.

DO NOT APPLY MORE THAN 1 LB. ORTHENE TOBACCO INSECT SPRAY PER ACRE AS A TRANSPLANT WATER APPLICATION AS SOME PHYTOTOXICITY MAY OCCUR.

FOLIAR APPLICATION

CROP	PEST	LBS. ORTHENE TOBACCO INSECT SPRAY PER ACRE
Tobacco	Grasshopper, Green Peach Aphid, Tobacco Aphid, Flea Beetle, Hornworm	1/2 to 1
Dark Leaf-Curred	Budworm, Cabbage Looper, Cutworm	1/2

Apply in 10 to 50 gals. water per acre with ground equipment or a minimum of 3 gals. per acre by air. Apply on a 7 day schedule or as needed. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest. Do not re-enter sprayed areas until the spray deposit has dried.

PLANT BED APPLICATION

Tobacco Bed Treatment	Ree Beede, Green Peach Aphid, Tobacco Aphid, Cutworm	1

Apply to foliage at the equivalent of 1 Tablespoon in 1 gal. of water per every 1800 sq. ft. bed. Apply evenly to insure thorough coverage.

SOIL APPLICATION

CROP	PEST	AMOUNT ORTHENE TOBACCO INSECT SPRAY
Tobacco	Imported Fire Ants	Mixed Treatment — Dry Method: Evenly distribute to 2 teaspoons over the mound. Drench Method: Mix 1 oz. in 5 gals. of water. Apply 1 gal. of mix to each mound area by sprinkling the mound until it is wet and treat a 10-14 foot diameter circle around the mound.

For best results apply the material in the early morning or late afternoon when the ants are most active. Applications made under prolonged hot and dry conditions may be ineffective due to the location of the ants deep within the nest. Treat maximum of 13 mounds per acre. Do not apply more than once per season. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

Do not apply under conditions where young plants are present, since damage might be incurred or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption.

NOTE: This product is sold by weight and package is full when packed, but due to fluffy nature this material is inclined to settle.

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


