CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed drink 1 or 2 glasses of water (or milk) and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. If possible contact a physician, Poison Control Center, or emergency center before inducing vomiting. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take person and product container to the nearest emergency treatment center. In case of eye contact, wash eyes immediately with fresh water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists. If inhaled, remove person from exposure site. If skin contact, wash skin with plenty of soap and water.

Note to Physicians: Emergency Information — call 1-800-457-2022. Aciprest is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If signs and symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear, atropine is antidotal. Z-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine but should not be used alone.

General Information: Use ORTHENE PCO Spray Concentrate for residual pest control in the areas listed by application of a 0.75% or 1.0% spray. Use the 0.75% rate for control of light infestations on nonporous surfaces and the 1.0% spray to quickly reduce heavy infestations. Activity of porous surfaces may be limited. Repeat treatment as needed. Not for use in food processing areas in food handling establishments.

Storage

Apply within Residential Buildings including Homes and Apartments; and within Industrial, Institutional, and Commercial Buildings including Restaurants, Warehouses, Stores, Hospitals, Hotels, Manufacturing Plants and Shops.

CONTROLES, ANTS, GRASSHOPPERS AND PESTERS: Apply as a coarse, low pressure spot spray, crack and crevice spray or with a pulse broom to treated areas where these pests are found or normally occur (including corners of rooms and closets; around television sets and radios; along

— and behind baseboards; around and under sinks, dishwashers, washing machines, refrigerators, stoves and cabinets; areas where plumbing enters or leaves the room; or other areas inhabited by these pests.

Note: A period of 3 to 7 days may be necessary for ORTHENE PCO Spray Concentrate to reach its maximum effect on cockroaches.

Earnips, Pillbugs and Sowbugs: Apply as a coarse low pressure spray to areas around doors and windows, storage areas, baseboards and other areas where these pests may enter or be found.

Pantry Pests—Exposed Stages (Confined Flea Beetle, Indian Meal Moth and Trogoderma): Apply ORTHENE PCO Spray Concentrate at 1.0% as a spot application to pantry and cupboard shelves where food content suspected of being infested are stored. Prior to spraying, remove all food stuffs, shelving paper and utensils. Do not replace the food packages until the surface has dried. Replace shelving paper. Infested food packages should be destroyed.

Wasps: Apply ORTHENE PCO Spray Concentrate as a spot application 0.5% to 1.0% to the nest, nest entrance, and surrounding areas where the wasps alight. Wasps are generally less active early and late in the day, so it is advisable that nests should be treated during these times.

Perimeter Treatment: To control Cockroaches, Ants, Pillbugs, and Etc., apply ORTHENE PCO Spray Concentrate at 0.5% to 1.0% to a baft of 6 to 10 feet adjacent to the structure, also to a height of 2 to 4 feet on the foundation where pests may be active or may find entrance. Also, apply as a residual spray or with a paint brush to surfaces buildings, window frames, shutters, entryways, screens, eaves, patios, garages, carports, around garbage areas and other areas where the pests congregate.

For Application on Spot Treatment— Spot treatments may be applied moderate pressures (up to 35 psi) using a coarse low tip. For spot treatments, no individual spot will exceed two (2) square feet.

For Orthene PCO Spray Concentrate according to dilution chart. Apply as a SPOT TREATMENT using coarse fan spray to areas inhabited by cockroaches. Treat areas such as baseboards, under and behind refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers and other equipment, as well as in storage areas, closets, sinks, cabinets, around windows, doors and water pipe.

Spot treatment should also include underneath of drawers, shelves and other areas where cockroaches frequent or travel.

Food Handling Establishments: For use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants and places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

Food Areas - Application Limited to Spots and/or Cracks and Crevices Treatment Only: Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing, cleaning, bottling, wrapping, heating, preparing, stable waste storage and enclosed processing systems (bins, docks, outside carts, sprays). Care should be taken to avoid dispersing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces. Applications of This Product in the Food Area of Food Handling Establishments, Other than as a Spot and/or Cracks and Crevices Treatment are not Permitted.

Non-Food Areas - Includes garages, rooms, laundry, tile areas (in lower patios and verandas), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, shop closets and storage. Spray concentration shall be limited to a maximum of 1.0% active ingredient. Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, potato and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

Storage Areas - Facilities where prepared foods are stored, such as dining rooms, but including areas where foods may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to sensitive surfaces such as baseboards, under curtains of construction into cracks and crevices. Avoid direct surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not spray when facility is in operation or when food is present). Do not allow spray or mist to contact food, containers or outer wraps. Utensils and food handling equipment should be thoroughly cleaned at least once a month to eliminate the possibility of this product.

Closets: Do not apply directly to carpet as discoloration may occur. Do not treat insulated laundry bins in poorly ventilated areas such as garages or basements, especially where moisture or high humidity exists since persistent odor could develop.
