Dear Mr. Schreier,

The Revised Basic CSF dated 12/8/05, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable. Thereby superseding previously accepted Basic CSF dated 7/11/91. A copy of the label stamped "Accepted With Comments" which changes the active ingredient concentration from 75.5% to 78.1% is enclosed. Submit a final printed label by March 20, 2006 which makes the following changes:

1. The following statements, in the section "Disclaimer, Risks of using this Product, Limited Warranty and Limitation" must be revised as outlined below.

- A. Append the final sentence of the subsection "Risks of using this Product" to read as or variation thereof: "...ALL SUCH RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH ...ARE ASSUMED BY THE BUYER TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW."
- B. In the following paragraph, the final sentence "Buyer assumes all risks...", must read as or variation thereof: "To the extent permitted by law buyer assumes all risks..."
- C. The subsection "Limitation of Liability" must begin as or variation thereof: "To the extent permitted by law in no event shall Valent or Seller..."

For as currently written the statement negates and/or detracts from labeling requirements as set forth by the Agency in 40 CFR Part 156, and is, therefore, considered misbranding."


If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release of the product for shipment constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
