Rice (California Only)	Barnyardgrass (Watergrass) Sprangletop Smallflower Umbrellaplant	26.7 lbs.	Apply after flooding when rice is in the expanded two-leaf stage (first open leaf). Do not apply if rice exhibit symptoms of stress. The variety Cal Pearl may react adversely to some stress conditions more than other varieties.
		•	Barnyardgrass beyond the two-leaf stage and Smallflower Umbrellaplant beyond the three-leaf stage may not be controlled. Smallflower Umbrellaplant must be submerged for optimum control. Cold weather during the planting season may result in decreased weed control due to prolonged period of weed seed germination.
			Do not drain BOLERO 15 G, treated fields for a minimum of 14 days after application, except where state regulation may allow shorter water holding periods for hydrologically isolated fields (as verified by the County Agricultural Commissioner), or for fields associated with systems designed to isolate discharged water from natural bodies of water. 			Suggested management practices which will help promote soil conditions conducive for the production of healthy rice treated with BOLERO 15 G include:
			Burn crop residue where state regulations allow, or straw removal.
			Fall plowing/discing of crop straw.
			Chemical "burndown" of green vegetation after fall plowing/discing prior to final seed bed preparation.
		•	Uniform flood depth of 3-4."
			Water-seeded rice fields treated with BOLERO 15 G post flood should be inspected regularly during tillering.
