Dear Ms. Charlton:

The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(B), subject to the following conditions:

- 1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/registration/registration review of your product under FIFRA when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Per the Agency letter for EPA Reg. Number 59639-140 dated 1/29/2018, Valent is required to submit to the Agency field rotational crop studies for canola (field trial); peanut (field trial); and soybean (field trial and processing). The studies must employ the desired PBI and follow the instructions provided in OCSPP 860.1520 and 860.1900. The deadline for you to submit these required data, as well as petition, NOF, and revised labels, to the Agency is 04/30/2020. Your failure to provide these data in a timely or adequate manner may result in initiation of a cancellation action against your registration.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency.
