The application referred to above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA section 3(c)(5).

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6.

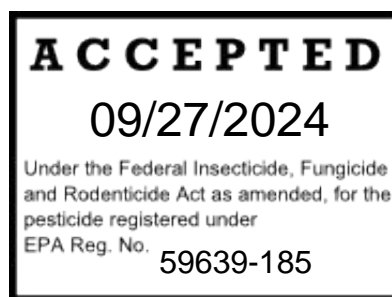

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Inside the fiber drum are two plastic liners. There are one or two activated charcoal packets inside the inner liner with the Ethaboxam Technical, and one or two packets between the inner and outer liners. They must be removed before using the Ethaboxam Technical. Seal the packets in a plastic bag until they are used again for a partial drum, or disposed of. Completely empty liners by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into formulation equipment. Dispose of packets as hazardous waste using RCRA Hazardous Waste Number P063 (hydrogen cyanide). Offer liners and fiber drum for recycling if available or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures allowed by State and local authorities.

RECYCLING

Once cleaned, some agricultural plastic pesticide containers can be taken to a container collection site or picked up for recycling.
