Dear Ms. Laird,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions listed below.

- Update Storage/Disposal and First Aid Statements

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Remove the heading and subheading, "Precautionary Statements and Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals" from the front panel. It must appear above the actual statements on the right panel.
2. This product's "Precautionary Statements" must be update to reflect the current toxicology profile for substantially similar product; revise the statements to read *"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Maybe fatal if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Do not breathe dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles or faceshield), protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."*
3. Revise the "First Aid" statements to include *"If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."*

4. Since this product is packaged in containers ranging from 0.6-20 lbs, the master label must carry Storage and Disposal instructions for containers 5 lbs or less and containers greater than 5 lbs. Revise as follows:

(Containers 5 lbs. or less)

Storage and Disposal: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store below 25°F or above 100°F for extended periods. Discard container in trash.

(Containers greater than 5 lbs.)

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store below 25°F or above 100°F for extended periods. Open dumping is prohibited.

The "Container and Pesticide Disposal" statements on the proposed label are acceptable.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, amended, for the pesticide registered under EPA Reg.

DANGER, CORROSIVE:
CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible damage to eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water before reuse.

Storage And Disposal

Keep container closed when not in use. Store at 50 to 90 degrees F for extended periods. PROHIBITIONS: Do not contain in food containers. Open dumping prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by other means, they should be incinerated at a temperature of 2000 degrees F. If incineration is not available, contact your state pesticide or hazardous waste office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Tripartite. Then offer for recycling or incineration in a burn container. If burned, stay away from the fire.
