SIMPLE INSTALLATION

1. Drain your water system.
2. Install the filter in the cold water line between the pump and the chosen faucet, as close to the faucet as you can. If the filter is installed to serve more than one faucet, the effect may be reduced.

NOTE: Never install the filter before the pump except hand pumps.

3. Select a mounting site where the filter will not strain the plumbing and where it can be secured with the mounting bracket and strap provided. Fit the bracket.

4. Make sure that the water will flow in the direction indicated by the arrows on the label.

5. If using hose, secure it with clamps. If using threaded connectors, cut off the hose borbis before making connections.

6. Secure the filter firmly in place.

7. Fill the system with POTABLE water. (Water that is safe to drink). This unit is to be used with municipally treated cold tap water only in the home, RVs or boats.

8. Run system and check for leaks. Run water until any loose carbon particles are flushed out.

9. Mark a replacement date, not more than 12 months ahead, on the label provided and place the label near the faucet.

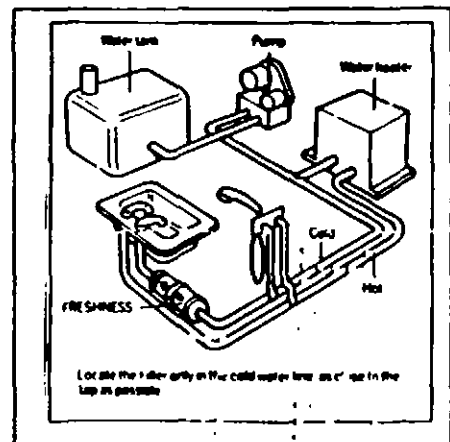
CAPACITY

This unit has a capacity of up to 2,000 gallons. It is capable of treating 5 gallons of cold tap water daily for a period of 12 months. Toward the end of the 12 months, you may notice a diminishing of the water flow. This will indicate that the unit is nearing the end of it's useful life.
