For best results apply to bare ground when weed growth is beginning. Weeds taller than 4-6 inches should be hoed first or it may be necessary to apply a second treatment.

Dilute up to 8:1 (16-24oz. per 2.5 gallon of water) To cover 100 sq. ft.
Dilute 2-2.75 quarts in sufficient amount of water for hard to control weeds such as perennial broadleaf, binweed and johnson grass as well as common mullein and wild carrot.

Different grades of mineral oil, diesel fuel, petroleum-based oil, fuel oil, or kerosene may be substituted for water.

Triple rise all containers and pour rinsate on area treated once application is completed. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONS:

- 1: Apply when air is calm to avoid possibility of drift.
- 2: Keep away from roots of desirable plants and trees.
- 3: Use only in areas where complete control of all vegetation is desired.
- 4: Do Not use on cultivated areas, slopes, greenhouses or near drip lines.
- 5: Keep Children and animals off treated areas until area is dry.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with clothing or skin. Avoid breathing vapor or mist. Wear Safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
