**WARNING:** Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. ## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Watercide CH is used to control algae and bacteria in industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use, systems should be cleaned of algae growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Apply 1.1 to 6.6 fluid ounces of Watercide CH per 1000 gallons of water per day until control is evident.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.1 to 6.6 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days, or as often as needed, depending upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the same manner as the initial application.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not store in high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Containers should be placed in overpack drums for disposal. Spills should be cleaned up and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep containers closed when not in use.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Never empty or allow to empty a pesticide container into the water, soil, or air. Do not burn or incinerate. Do not use for any other purpose. For disposal instructions, contact the Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Management and Emergency Response Regional Office for guidance.

### CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

- METAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then crush or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other means approved by state and local authorities.
- PLASTIC: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then crush or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other means approved by state and local authorities, by burning, if burned, in accordance with local or state regulations.
