
The revised Confidential Statement of Formula dated November 5, 1997 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the label claim and is acceptable.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Strong oxidizer. Do not mix with alkalis or materials above pH 4.0, reducing agents, organic materials, wood, paper and combustibles. Do not contaminate with iron, copper or other heavy metals. Avoid contamination of any kind. Keep away from heat and sunlight. Never return unused material to the original container for storage.

**SPILLS:** Keep people away from spillage. Dilute with large volumes of water and flush to sewer if local, state and federal regulations permit, or collect and allow to decompose before disposal.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish, and aquatic invertebrates. Caution should be used when applying indoors because pets may be at risk. #### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

For use in nursing homes, residential homes, mobile homes, hospitals, clinics, veterinary clinics, treatment centers, prisons, schools, industrial plants, offices, retail stores, passenger terminals, recreational buildings, bowling alleys, bars, restaurants, kitchens, bakeries, night clubs, theaters, beauty and barber shops, banks, funeral homes, garages, warehouses, and convention centers, hotels, motels, cafeterias, and public buildings. For use on floors, walls, ceilings and hard, porous and non-porous surfaces.

This product is intended for use by trained service persons engaged in cleaning and sanitizing ceilings and walls. Coustic-Glo Cleaning Sanitizing B<sub>2</sub> System consists of three parts. B<sub>2</sub> is a

solution containing hydrogen peroxide as a sanitizing agent, B<sub>1</sub> is a compatible cleaning detergent which enhances cleaning. B<sub>3</sub> is a cleaner which acts in a synergistic manner with B<sub>1</sub> and B<sub>2</sub> to further enhance cleaning.

**Step 1 Preparation of the area.** Remove all people, pets and foliage. Secure area to prevent reentry by unauthorized personnel until the proper time. Cover all carpet with butyl coated canvas tarps. Cover other items with a paper/poly laminated tarps.

**Step 2 Remove dust and dirt** from area to be cleaned using a soft sweep broom, vacuuming or air blowing.

**Step 3 Mixing.** Put on the required personal protective gear. Dilute 1 qt. of B<sub>1</sub> concentrate with water to make 5 gallons. Then mix 7 pints of diluted B<sub>1</sub> with 1 pint of Cleaner Sanitizer B<sub>2</sub> and 5 oz. (scoops) of B<sub>3</sub> powder. Mix well until B<sub>3</sub> powder is dissolved. Mix just prior use and mix only the amount needed. The mixed solution is good for up to 2 hours.

**Step 4 Application.** Apply using a mechanical sprayer and spray wand at a rate of 600-700 sq. ft./gallon on area to be cleaned and sanitized. Allow 5 minutes contact time for sanitizing. After application the metal grid rails are wiped with a sponge washed in clean water to remove cleaner from metal rails. Leave covering tarps on for at least one hour for an 8' ceiling and longer for a higher ceiling. Remove tarps and ventilate area well. Prevent reentry for 1 hour after ventilating.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool area away from sunlight and heat. Store only in compatible plastic, aluminum or glass containers. Store away from children.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Dispose in sewer, but only in accordance with a NPDES permit and local, state and federal regulations permit. Contact regional EPA office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Rinse container thoroughly with water and dispose of in normal trash if local, state and federal regulations permit. Otherwise dispose in a secured landfill.
