This product is intended for commercial and industrial use by service persons engaged in cleaning of ceilings in homes, schools, hospitals, and public buildings. Its purpose is two-fold: to serve as a cleaning and bleaching agent of soiled surfaces, and to sanitize the cleaned surfaces. If surfaces are heavily soiled they should be washed with a suitable detergent and rinsed before applying Coustic-Glo Ceiling Cleaner-Sanitizer C<sub>1</sub>.

This is our C cleaning sanitizing system, which consists of two parts: C<sub>1</sub> is a solution containing sodium hypochlorite as a sanitizing agent and C<sub>2</sub> is an aqueous mixture containing a compatible detergent and a fragrance, which when mixed with the sanitizing agent it enhances the cleaning properties of our C system.

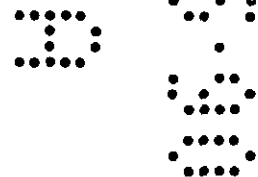
