



It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label

This product is intended for commercial and industrial use by service persons engaged in cleaning of ceilings in homes, schools, hospitals, and public buildings. Its purpose is two-toid: to serve as a cleaning and bleaching agent of soiled surfaces, and to sanitize the cleaned surfaces. If surfaces are heavily soiled they should be washed with a suitable detergent and rinsed before applying Coustic-Gio Ceiling Cleaner-Sanitizer Ci.

This is our C cleaning sanitizing system, which consists of two parts:  $C_1$  is a solution containing sodium hypochlorite and  $C_2$  is an aqueous mixture containing a compatible detergent and a fragrance, which when mixed with the sanitizing agent enhances the cleaning properties of our C system.

To cover a ceiling approximately 800 to 1000 square feet, the spray solution is prepared just before use by adding 16 fluid ounces of C<sub>2</sub> to one gallon (128 fluid ounces) of C<sub>1</sub>. The solution is mixed well and used within 15 minutes. The solution is sprayed onto the treated surfaces with a mechanical sprayer and allowed to slowly evaporate until the surfaces are dry. The used solution is good for up to two hours. Unused solution after that time should be discarded and a fresh solution prepared to complete the treatment as necessary, depending on square feet of surface to be treated. Do not allow occupancy of the treated spaces until surfaces are dry and the areas thoroughly ventiliated. Remove pets or aquaria before spraying. Remove all food or perishable food items that may come in contact with spray solution before spraying areas. Do not allow spray solution to come in contact with food or teed items.
