- f. Diatomaceous earth (DE) is not 100% insecticidal. Approximately 10% of pure DE is inert. Thus you must revise the active ingredient statement and confidential statement of formula to reflect that portion of DE that is insecticidal and the remaining portion included in the total percentage of inert ingredients.

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

This odorless, non-staining, non-flammable powder remains effective in the control of insects for as long as Insectigone is present.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS:

Remove cap and cut tip above the top line with scissors or knife.

INDOOR USE: COCKROACHES, ANTS, EARWIGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, MILLIPEDES and CENTIPEDES.

Lightly coat a thin layer of dust in areas where these pests are found or may hide such as cracks and crevices, behind and beneath stoves, refrigerators, sinks, cabinets, garbage cans, around pipes and drains, window frames and in attics and basements. Hit insects directly where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FLEAS: Thoroughly dust floor area of pet's sleeping quarters, as well as surrounding cracks, crevices, baseboards, behind pictures and wherever presence of these insects is suspected.

CARPET BEETLES: Thoroughly dust along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under furniture, under carpeting and rugs and in closets and shelving wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

BEDBUGS: Take bed apart. Dust into joints and channels. If hollow, such as square or round tubing, see that the interior of the framework is well dusted. Mattresses should be dusted, especially tufts, folds and edges. Picture frame moldings and all cracks and crevices in the room should be treated.

OUTDOOR USE: EARWIGS, ANTS, CRICKETS, SLUGS, MILLIPEDES AND CENTIPEDES.

Lightly coat a thin layer of dust in areas where these pests are found or may hide including patios, windows, door frames and sills, outside of entrance ways, around foundations and along ant trails. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Note: A 7 oz. container of CHEMFREE Insectigone Crawling Insect Killer will provide a thorough treatment for an average home or treat a garage and basement.
