


  - a. Revise the EPA Reg. No. so it reads, "EPA Reg. No. 59913-14."
  - b. Revise all references to "ants" so they read, "ants (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants). Additional data are required to support claims against these types of ants."
  - c. Add the following statement to the label: "For use around the home and home greenhouses only."
  - d. Under the Directions for Use, delete the word "General" from the heading, "General Precautions and Restrictions." The word implies that the information is advisory, not mandatory.
  
- 4. For future submissions, make the following changes to your Confidential Statement of Formulation (EPA Form 8570-4):
  - a. Box 4: Revise the EPA Reg. No. so it reads, "EPA Reg. No. 59913-14."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. [Bottle (32 oz.) will treat (cover) 175 sq. ft.] Use as directed above on apples, avocados, citrus (grapefruit, lemons, oranges, tangerines, limes), peaches, nectarines, apricots, pears, almonds, pecans, walnuts, kiwi fruit, blackberries, loganberries, raspberries, strawberries and grapes to kill JAPANESE BEETLES, FLEA BEETLES, WEEVIL ADULTS, CATERPILLARS (including NAVAL ORANGE WORM, BAGWORMS, LEAFTIERS, CODLING MOTH, and TENT CATERPILLARS), APHIDS, LEAFHOPPERS, PSYLLIDS, SCALE CRAWLERS, and SAWFLY LARVAE.
