Within five to eight weeks there is considerable ant mortality and a continual decline of the fire ant colony. This product will kill the queens as well as worker ants, thus there is no need to apply additional poisons to the area.

Apply Bushwhacker when the ground is dry and there is no rain anticipated for 2 or 3 days. Do not apply in strong wind. For best results apply in cool weather or in early morning or late afternoon.

Application Directions for Broadcast Treatment

- A. <u>Restrictions:</u> Do not broadcast to ditchbanks, food or feed crops livestock areas, pasture, or rangeland. This product can only be broadcast in the following sites and under the indicated restrictions:
 - 1. Non-Crop and Non-Agricultural Areas Lawns, turf, parks, golf courses, rights-of-way where no livestock are present.

B. Instructions:

1. Methods of Applications

- a. A walk-behind or carried rotary spreader with an auger feed.
- b. Commercial power-take-off-driven or battery powered rotary spreaders.
- c. Fixed wing aircraft.

2. Rates

Broadcast Bushwhacker evenly over the area at the rate of three (3) pounds per acre. See General Instructions for Equipment Calibration.

3. Retreatment Interval

A second application at the above rates may be made after 5 days in severely infested areas. Allow 6 to 8 weeks for signs of mound activity to begin to disappear.

4. General Instructions for Equipment Calibration

Caution: Be sure to check the actual application rate under normal operating conditions.

- a. Fill hopper.
- b. Determine from the spreader specifications the "throw" distance for the spreader in use.
- c. Set the spreader to initial settings noted on the spreader specifications for a rate of three pounds per acre.
- d. Attach a plastic bag over the discharge opening.
- e. Measure off a small area of 100 square feet and traverse this premeasured plot at the desired speed. Be sure to allow for the "throw" distance with a slight overlap.
- f. Weigh the contents of the bag and multiply by 10 and pour have the amount of material the spreader applies over 1000 to 15.
- g. Determine from this calculation whether you need to open or close the spreader opening to achieve a rate of three pounds per acre (approximately one ounce/1000 sq. ft. is desired).
- h. If the result is over or under the desired rate adjust the settings and repeat the calibration.

A. <u>Restrictions:</u> This product can be used for mound treatment in the following sites: citrus orchard floors, pasture, rangeland, nurseries, sod farms, lawns, turf, parks, golf courses, rights-of-way, field crops, vegetables, nut tree farms, and other horticultural plant areas.

Apply one heaping teaspoonful per mound by sprinkling Bushwhacker lightly over the top of the mound and around the mound.
