**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

**Description:** SSCC-3359 Sap Stain Control is a liquid concentrate containing an effective fungicide for the control of sap stain and surface staining fungi that cause discoloration and staining of freshly sawn lumber. SSCC-3359 Sap Stain Control is an aqueous solution which may be applied to dimensional lumber, logs, plywood and particle board to prevent surface mold growth.

**Dilution Ratio:** SSCC-3359 Sap Stain Control is a concentrate dilutable with water. For lumber 2" or less in thickness, use 1 gallon of Concentrate per 150 gallons of water to protect against sap staining organisms during protected storage periods. For lumber thicker than 2" or where temperature and humidity conditions promote severe sap stain, use 1 gallon of concentrate per 100 gallons of water, or 1 gallon per 75 gallons of water. For spray systems use 1 gallon of concentrate per 10 to 100 gallons of water.

**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Application:** Flood spray or dip the freshly sawn clean lumber to be treated in SSCC-3359 Sap Stain Control solution within 24 hours after cutting. A dip of 15 seconds or more is sufficient. If not treated within 24 hours, stain may occur.

Lumber should be totally immersed or sprayed to insure treatment. Tanks should be covered by a roof to prevent the addition of rain water and consequent dilution of the solution. Vats and spray equipment should be cleaned regularly to remove sawdust and other debris. Freshly treated lumber should not be exposed to water. Store in protected area from rain and stack properly for best results.

**Clean Up:** Use water to clean immersion tanks, spray equipment and surrounding area. Soapy water may be required to remove SSCC-3359 Sap Stain Control from floors and equipment.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a closed, properly labeled container in a cool place. If static generating conditions exist, provide necessary grounding and bonding. Keep containers closed when not in use.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**Container Disposal:** Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
