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Recommendations

The Subject product requires significant revisions in order to conform with the RED, Technical Reviews and Agency label policies (See Appendices I & II)

The subject product label does not contain risk mitigation labeling requirements as specified in the RED.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this production in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

This product can be used for all above ground applications. Do not use this product where any portion of the treated wood will be below ground. Sealers are necessary if frequent or prolonged dermal contact is expected. Do not use on wood that will be in contact with food, feed or potable water. Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use where dairy cattle or livestock can come into contact with treated wood. Applying paints and stains often result in splashing or dripping. Cover desirable plants and shrubs to protect against possible injury. Cut and machine wood prior to treatment if possible. If not, liberally apply two coats of preservative to all joints, cracks, holes or other openings. For best results and uniformity of appearance, retreat once every three years.

USES: Woodlife® Milltreat Type F VM&P provides a protective, decorative finish for millwork, siding, fences, decks, patios and other wood products.

COVERAGE: 100 to 150 sq. ft./gal. Depending on the porosity of the wood.

PREPARATION:

1. For best results, all cutting, gluing and sanding should be done before applying Woodlife® Milltreat Type F VM&P. Wood must be clean, dry and free from foreign material. This product can be used on unfinished new wood or unfinished weathered wood.
2. Stains and paints should be stripped for best results. Do not use steel wool. If mildew is present, remove by washing with a 50% dilution of household bleach followed by water. If extractive bleeding has occurred, scrub with a diluted solution of oxalic acid (1/4 lb. per gallon of water) and then wash at once with clear water. Always wear rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when using bleach and oxalic acid.
3. Allow surface to dry before applying.

APPLICATION

1. Stir well before using. No thinning is required. The temperature of the wood and the Woodlife® Milltreat Type F VM&P should be 40°F or above.
2. This product may be applied only by dipping, roller or brush. Do not spray. When roller coating, use a brush to finish edges and grooves. Be sure to brush thoroughly so that all surfaces are completely wetted and covered. Coat side and end grain of wood with consecutive coats until thirst for solution has been filled. If two coats are desired, be sure to apply second coat before the first coat has dried.
3. Any surface cut after treatment should be retreated.

DRYING TIME: A minimum of 24 - 48 hours depending on conditions and method of application. On humid days, longer drying time may be required.

CLEAN UP: Use mineral spirits to remove wet Woodlife® Milltreat Type F-VM&P from all surfaces, brushes and rollers.
