DIRECTIONS FOR USE (After Dilution)

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DESCRIPTION: Waterborne Milltreat 5:1 Concentrate is a clear, penetrating, paintable, water repellent preservative for wood. It protects against decay fungi (such as brown or white rot), staining fungi (such as blue stain), surface mold (such as black, brown or other colored mildew) and dimensional change.

PRODUCT USES: Millwork, shingles, siding, plywood, hardboard, flakeboard, structural lumber (above ground use only). DO NOT USE ON WOOD WHICH WILL COME IN CONTACT WITH FOOD. DO NOT USE ON WOOD WHICH WILL COME IN CONTINUOUS CONTACT WITH THE SKIN UNLESS THE WOOD IS SEALED WITH PAINT, VARNISH OR SHELLAC AFTER TREATMENT. Keep container closed when not in use.

RETENTION: 3 minute immersion - 5 to 10 gallons per MBF, 30 minute immersion - 10 to 15 gallons per MBF. Brush application - 150 sq. ft. per gallon, but varies by species and condition of the substrate.

PREPARATION: Machine, cut, glue and sand wood as desired before treating. Do not use over previously finished or stained wood without stripping off old finish. Do not use steel wool. Wood must be clean and dry.

APPLICATION: Treating solution, wood and surrounding air must be above 40°F (4.4°C). Apply by immersion, roller coater, flood spray or brush. Any surface cut after first treatment should be retreated.

IMMERSION: Millwork or other items to be painted - 3 minutes. Treatment should be in accordance with Industrial Standard IS-4. Use only items for above ground exposure.

FINISHING: Before glazing, painting or varnishing, treatment should be completely-dry and odos free. Allow 4 to 8 hours under average temperature and humidity conditions. Can be heat-dried for flant production. Use a sealer such as shellac before using lacquers.

CLEAN UP: Use water and deleggent to clean itemersion tanks, spray equipment and surrounding area. Mineral spirits or paint thinner may be required to remove dried-Waterborne Milltreat 5:1 Concentrate.
