### CONSULT MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET BEFORE USING

Apply this product only as specified on label.  
Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons.  
Do not use on wood that will be in contact with food, feed or potable water.  
Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use where dairy cattle or livestock can come into contact with treated wood.  
Do not use this product where any portion of the treated wood will be below ground.  
Sealers are necessary if frequent or prolonged dermal contact is expected.  
Apply paints and stains often result in splashing and dripping. Cover desirable plants and shrubs to protect against possible injury.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Woodlife® F is a clear penetrating non-swelling paintable water repellent for natural wood surfaces. No unpleasant odor. Will not crack, blister or peel. Ready to use, colorless when dry. Completes the total protection of above ground pressure-treated wood from water damage and rot. Ideal for all natural wood surfaces, unfinished new or unfinished weathered wood and pressure-treated wood.  
**PRODUCT USES:** Millwork, shingles, siding, plywood, hardboard, flakeboard, structural lumber, fences, and other exterior wood products. Keep containers and freshly treated articles away from food and living plants. DO NOT USE ON WOOD WHICH WILL COME IN CONTACT WITH FOOD. Do not use on wood which will come into continuous contact with the skin unless the wood is sealed with paint, varnish or shellac after application. Keep container closed when not in use.

**RETENTION:** 3-Minute immersion—5 to 10 gallons per MGF (i.e. 1,000 board feet). Brush application—150 sq. ft. per gallon but varies with species and condition of the substrate.  
**PREPARATION:** Machine, cut, glue and sand wood as desired before treating. Do not use over previously finished or stained wood without stripping off old finish. Do not use steel wool. Wood must be clean and dry.  
**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:** Treating solution, wood and surrounding air must be above 40°F (4°C). Apply by immersion, vacuum, roller, cedar, food spray or brush. Do not use high-pressure spray. Any surface cut after first treatment must be retreated.

**IMMERSION:** Millwork or other items to be painted—3 minutes. Treatment must be in accordance with Industrial Standard IS-4. Use only on items for above ground exposure.  
**FINISHING:** Before glazing, painting or varnishing, treatment must be completely dry and odor free. Allow 24 to 48 hours under average temperature and humidity conditions. Can be heat-dried for plant production. Use a seal or such as shellac before using lacquers.  
**CLEAN UP:** Use mineral spirits to clean immersion tanks, spray equipment and surrounding areas. Mineral spirits or paint thinner may be used to remove dried Woodlife® F.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
**Storage:** Store in a closed, properly labeled container in a cool place. If static generating conditions exist, provide necessary grounding and bonding. Keep containers closed when not in use.  
**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or insecticide is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.  
**Container Handling:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/2 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available.
